Chin has been recognised with an Outstanding Service Award in 2011 with the Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth, Singapore where she has served as a Heritage Education Officer for the past 10 years. She also led 2 teams to bag the Innovation Awards in Public Service in 2012 and 2014.

Working on over 35 special exhibitions and collections in permanent galleries managed by National Heritage Board, Singapore enabled Chin to become a highly motivated, creative and resourceful thought leader in the field of museum education, gallery interpretation and school-museum programs. She garnered a Fellowship with American Alliance of Museums in 2013.
